

## USDA BUY AMERICAN CERTIFICATION FORM

Dear Customer,

Section 104(d) of the William F. Goodling Child Nutrition Reauthorization Act of 1998 requires schools and institutions participating in the NSLP and SBP in the contiguous United States to purchase to maximum extent practicable, domestic commodities or products for use in meals served under the program.

The legislation defines "domestic commodity or product" as one that is produced in the United States and is processed in the United States, substantially using agricultural commodities that are produced in the United States. Any product processed by a responsive vendor must contain over 51% of the food component, by weight or volume, from U.S. origin.
