Dear Valued SideKicks® Customer:

Section 104(d) of the William F. Goodling Child Nutrition Reauthorization Act of 1998 requires schools and institutions participating in the NSLP and SBP in the contiguous United States to purchase to the maximum extent practicable, domestic commodities or products for use in meals served under the program.

The legislation defines “domestic commodity or product” as one that is: 1) produced in the United States, and 2) processed in the United States, substantially using agricultural commodities that are produced in the United States. One of the reports accompanying the legislation noted that “substantially” means that over 51% of the final processed product consists of agricultural commodities that were grown domestically.

Country Pure Foods is pleased to certify that our entire line of Smooth Frozen® SideKicks® fruit and vegetable juice products comply with the W. F. Goodling Buy American Act as these products are: 1) produced in the United States, and 2) contain 51% or more domestic U.S. agricultural products (juice concentrates).
